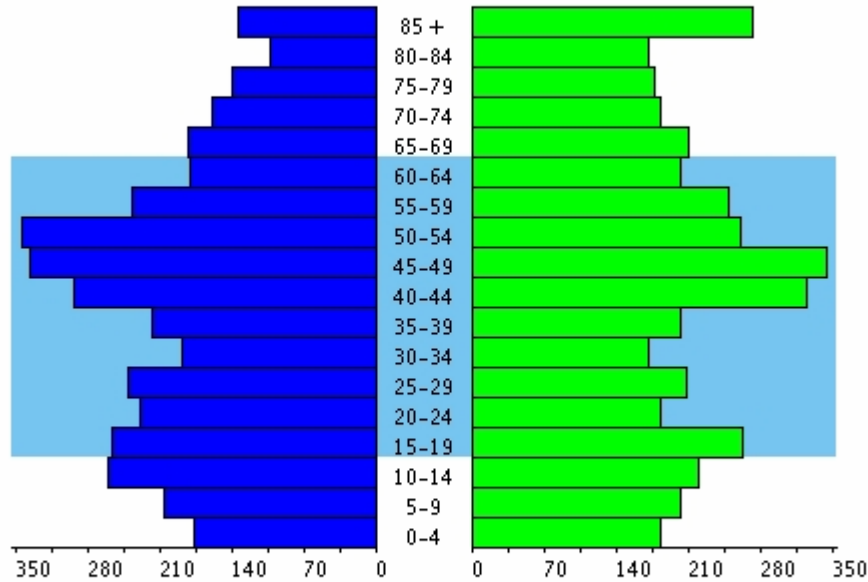

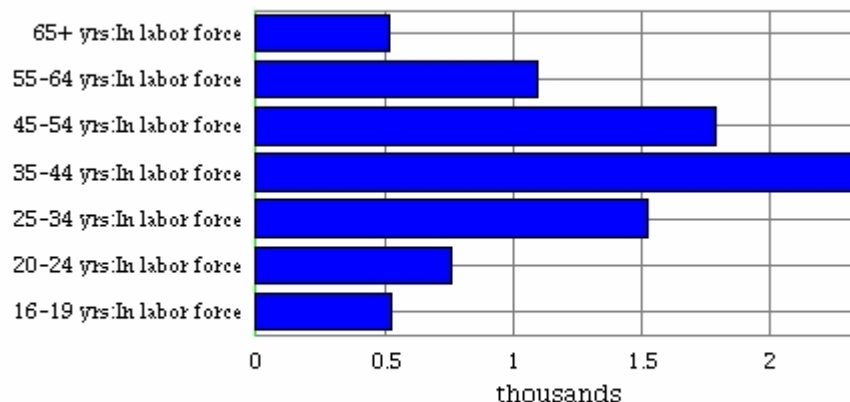

Labor Force Size by Age

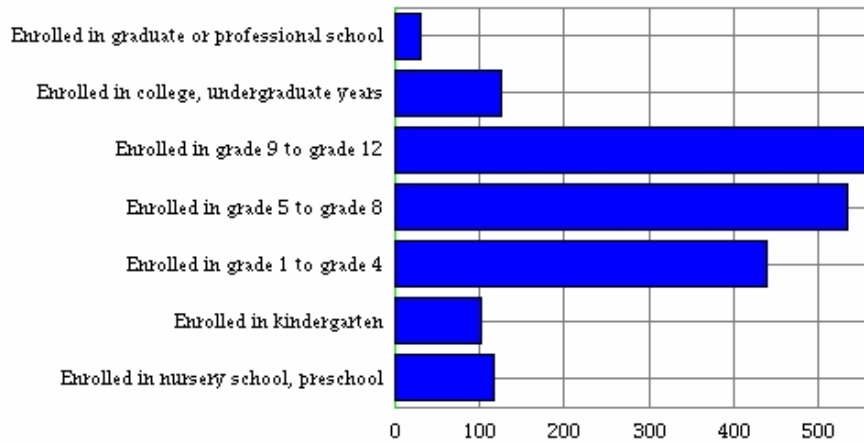

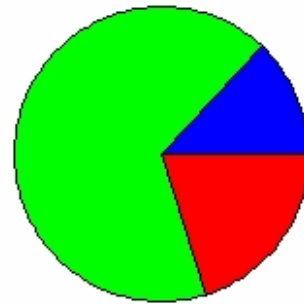

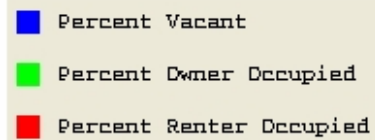

(All Housing Units)



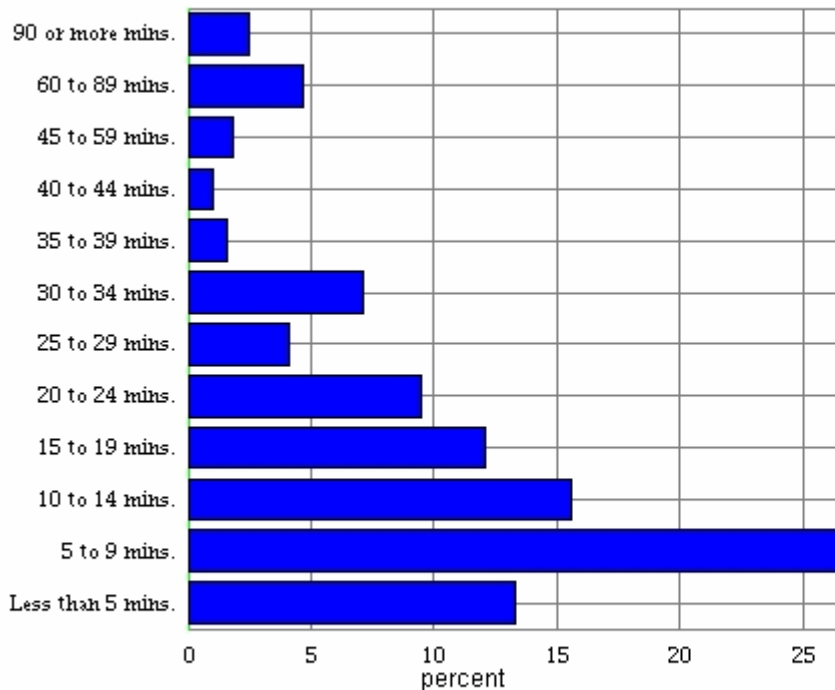
